

Cowley County Regular Commission Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, May 11, 2010

The Board of County Commission met in regular session Tuesday, May 11, 2010 at 7:00 pm. Those present were Chairman Alan Groom, Vice Chairman Gary Wilson and Commissioner Dick Bonfy. Also present was Leroy Alsup, County Administrator and Karen Defore, County Clerk. Also in attendance were Lorri Lowe, Travis Lowe, Wayne Wilt, Bill Mueller, Dakota Davis and Allen Twitchell.

- Vice Chairman Gary Wilson delivered the invocation.
- Commissioner Bonfy moved, Vice Chairman Wilson seconded to approve the minutes of the Regular County Commission Meeting held on May 4, 2010 as presented. Vote 3-0
- Lorri Lowe, City Clerk for the City of Burden addressed Commissioners regarding a request for support for the City of Burden's "Paint the Town" project. Mrs. Lowe stated about 60 youth from around the state will arrive in Burden on June 1 to help paint the town of Burden. Burden is in need of paint and painting supplies to make this event happen. Burden will also have their Annual Burden Celebration October 8-10. After some discussion, Vice Chairman Wilson moved, Chairman Groom seconded to grant the sum of \$1,000 to the City of Burden in support of the City of Burden's "Paint the Town" project and the annual Burden Celebration. Vote 3-0
- Commissioners signed an order to void check numbers 151693, 150656 and 151728.
- Commissioners signed abatements 2009-520 -551, 554-558.
- Commissioners signed payroll deposit for the payroll period dated 04/18/10 to 05/01/10 taken to CornerBank on May 5, 2010 in the amount of \$213,213.40.
- Chairman Groom moved, Vice Chairman Wilson seconded to recess into executive session with the County Administrator for personnel matters of non-elected personnel; to reconvene in this meeting room at 7:25 pm. Vote 3-0
- Commissioners returned from executive session, Chairman Groom stated there was no decision made or action taken in the executive session.
- There being no further business, Chairman Groom moved, Commissioner Bonfy seconded to adjourn at 7:25 pm. Vote 3-0
