

Cowley County Regular Commission Meeting Minutes  
Tuesday, June 8, 2010

The Board of County Commission met in regular session Tuesday, June 8, 2010 at 7:00 pm. Those present were Chairman Alan Groom, Vice Chairman Gary Wilson and Commissioner Dick Bonfy. Also present were Leroy Alsup, County Administrator and Karen Defore, County Clerk. Also in attendance were Bill Mueller, Don Read, Dolly Bonfy, Wanda Jackson, Jim McClung, Barry Barber, Wayne Wilt, Ed McGowan, Marvin Duncan, Don Donley, Albert Crane and Allen Twitchell.

- Chairman Alan Groom delivered the invocation.
- Vice Chairman Wilson moved, Commissioner Bonfy seconded to approve the minutes of the Regular County Commission Meeting held on June 1, 2010 as presented. Vote 3-0
- Jim McClung and Barry Barber representatives of Cowley County Conservation District addressed Commissioners regarding the budget request for FY2011. The budget request is for \$28,200, the same level of funding since 2006. They also presented the activities the organization has accomplished this past year. After some discussion, Chairman Groom stated the Commission would take the budget request under advisement when drafting the FY2011 County Budget.
- Albert Crane addressed Commissioners regarding purchasing several acres of land that the County currently owns adjacent to the old landfill, the site of the current transfer station. After some discussion, Commissioners requested information from staff and additional information from Mr. Crane then to schedule the item on a future agenda.
- Commissioners signed one journal entry.
- Commissioners signed payroll deposit for the payroll period dated 05/16/10 to 05/29/10 taken to CornerBank on June 3, 2010 in the amount of \$213,720.50.
- Commissioners signed abatements 2009-597 through 601 and 604.
- Karen Defore, County Clerk discussed the current maintenance contract and the addition of maintenance and cleaning required at the former bank building now that the engineer's office is occupying the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the building. Commissioners stated they would like to continue on with Pro Maintenance and possibly put the maintenance out for bid at the end of the year.
- Leroy Alsup, County Administrator discussed the window replacement project that was approved with no screen placement on the operable windows. Mr. Alsup stated one office had requested screens be placed on the window at the expense of that department, if screens were put on the window the screen would be on the inside of the window and not visible from the outside. Commissioners approved asking other departments if they would also like to have screens on their windows.
- Leroy Alsup, County Administrator discussed the upcoming budget meeting schedule. Mr. Alsup stated that there is a conflict with the meeting dates so the meetings will likely be pushed a week later.

- Leroy Alsup, County Administrator also stated on the next week's agenda it is likely that there will be a K9 demonstration by the Sheriff's Office of our new K9 unit.
- There being no further business, Chairman Groom moved, Vice Chairman Wilson seconded to adjourn at 7:40 pm. Vote 3-0
