

Cowley County Regular Commission Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, July 13, 2010

The Board of County Commission met in regular session Tuesday, July 13, 2010 at 7:00 pm. Those present were Vice Chairman Gary Wilson and Commissioner Dick Bonfy. Also present was Leroy Alsup, County Administrator, Karen Defore, County Clerk and Bill Taylor, County Counselor. Also in attendance were Darrin Green, Wayne Wilt, Eddie McGowan, Lynn McGowan, Dale Steward, Henry Hawkins, Bill Mueller and Allen Twitchell.

Vice Chairman Wilson delivered the invocation.

Commissioner Bonfy moved, Vice Chairman Wilson seconded to approve the minutes of the Regular County Commission Meeting held on July 6, 2010 as presented. Vote 2-0

Vice Chairman Wilson moved, Commissioner Bonfy seconded to approve the payment of the claims for the period of July 6, 2010 through July 13, 2010, check numbers 152315 through 152433 totaling \$775,960.44. Vote 2-0

Dale Steward, County Engineer addressed Commissioners regarding a right-of-way permit. Mr. Steward stated the permit requests deviates from normal practice due to an easement that could not be secured. The road will need to be cut as a result several modifications were placed in the permit to be sure the road is repaired to avoid future problems. The permit is for water lines to be laid to the new hospital. After some discussion, Commissioner Bonfy moved, Vice Chairman Wilson seconded to approve for execution the revised County Right-of-Way Permit application submitted by the City of Arkansas City to install two waterlines, a 16" diameter PVC and a 6" diameter PVC line at the southeast corner of 61st Road and 252nd Road. Vote 2-0

Vice Chairman Wilson brought up for discussion some complaints he has received about the railroad crossing on Cowley 3 near Kellogg. Dale Steward, County Engineer stated he would make contact with the railroad again.

Vice Chairman Wilson brought up for discussion the guardrail at the approach to the Chestnut Bridge. Mr. Steward stated nothing had been done to the guardrail but agreed the County needed to make some repairs.

Commissioners signed 2 journal entries.

Commissioners signed abatements 641, 644, 651 and 652.

Commissioners signed a call for a special meeting Thursday, July 15, 2010 at 1:30 pm.

There being no further business, Commissioner Bonfy moved, Vice Chairman Wilson seconded to adjourn at 7:15 pm. Vote 2-0
