The Opportunity Zones tax incentive was established by Congress in the 2017 Tax Cut and Jobs Act as an innovative approach to spur long-term private sector investments in low-income urban and rural communities nationwide. In May 2018 the IRS released the list of Kansas communities designated as qualified Opportunity Zones, including some property in Ark City.

The session will present an overview of Opportunity Zones, guidance provided by the Department of Treasury, and planning to make Opportunity Zones work for your communities.
